For Basic Coastal Cruising Students:

- Review the entire Sailing Made Easy
- Read Coastal Cruising Made Easy
- Answer the Review Questions in *Coastal Cruising Made Easy*
- Read and know the Federal Requirements booklet
- Complete the Sample Tests (Basic Keelboat as a review & Coastal Cruising sent via email
- Practice your knots: Cleat hitch, clove hitch, round turn and two half hitches, figure eight, reef knot, and bowline

For Bareboat Charter Students:

- Read and review Bareboat Cruising Made Easy, review the diagrams
- Answer the Review Questions on pages 78, 148 and 188 of *Bareboat Cruising Made Easy*
- Practice the above knots and two additional knots: Sheet bend and trucker's hitch
