## **Gear List:**

- ASA Logbook (if you are taking an ASA certification class)
- Boat shoes, enclosed sandal (no black marking soles)
- Sailing gloves
- Rain jacket, rain pants, rubber boots [optional (look at Douglas Gill Shorties or West Marine)], hat, warm gloves
- Warm clothing for layering (long underwear, t-neck, sweater, wooly socks), fleece, Smart Wool
- Sunglasses (with lanyard), hat (with hat clip), sunscreen
- Sleeping bag, pillow
- Towel, toiletries (shower at marina)
- Beverages for yourself (coffee, tea, juice, milk)
- Optional items: Flashlight, navigation tools, handheld compass, GPS, seasick remedies. Some people prefer Trans-Derm Scope (prescription), swimsuit

## **Meals Provided (Classes):**

- Lunches on days 1 & 2, all meals day 3 lunch through day 4 lunch. Please call now if you have special dietary needs. The boat has an alcohol stove and ice box.
- Family & Friends classes provision the boat for both their crew and captain.

## Directions to Bayfield (Pikes Bay Marina): 84190 Pikes Bay Rd, Bayfield, WI 54814

- From the Twin Cities, take Hwy 35 North to Duluth.
- Exit on Hwy 2 East. (535; the 2nd opportunity to go East)
- Go through Superior toward Ashland (approx. 60 miles).
- Exit Hwy 13 North.
- Take Hwy 13 North through Washburn and an additional 10 miles to Bayfield.
- Just south of Bayfield, take a right at the Waterford Condo sign/Pike's Bay Marina (the sign is just north of Port Superior on right side).
- Take the second right almost immediately down the hill to marina (just past the mailboxes).
- You'll pass the club house and ship's store halfway down the hill.
- The docks farthest to the left are docks 300, 400 & 500. We are in slips #327 (Taboo),

#322 (Jolly Swagman), #303 (Memories Maid) and #301 (Calico).

• Each boat will have a key fob (attached to a blue handle) to use the head in the marina.

NOTE: Please plan your arrival for the evening before your class is to begin. (Late arrivals are okay.)
